EASTERN LEAGUE MAY AWARDS

Rochester's Gordon Bags EL Top Batter for May: David Gordon battered Eastern League pitchers all May and wound up taking home the Batter of the Month Award. "I've been around Great Lakes Baseball League long enough to know you really have to work hard day in and day out to be able to put up this kind of consistency," the 29-year-old Gordon told reporters. "I put in a lot of work, even on the days I might not take the field, and it's always nice when everything comes together for me like it did this last month." In 22 games, Gordon hit .398 with no home runs, 17 RBIs and scored 20 runs.

Eastern League Picks Best Starter in May: Rob Curry took home the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month honors in May. After all these years playing ball, the 35-year-old veteran still enjoys the game as though he'd just broken camp for the first time a month ago. He's a bit older now with a few more aches and pains, but the old man has reason to celebrate, having gone 6-1 for Cleveland last month and claiming the Pitcher of the Month award. He tacked up a 2.17 ERA in his 6 starts, tossing 54 innings and striking out 21.

EL Selects Rookie Star of the Month: Weston Lowe is still a bit shy, but then, who could blame the newest Eastern League Rookie of the Month honoree? He hasn't been around the league long enough to fully know the ropes yet, despite the fact that he's putting up veteran-like numbers. In May the Buffalo hitter tagged opposing pitching for a .368 average with 25 hits, no home runs and 7 RBIs.

WESTERN LEAGUE MAY AWARDS

Kalamazoo's Jordan Snags May Batting Title: Seasoned by several years of professional experience, 31-year-old Roger Jordan put together a solid offensive month for Kalamazoo and was crowned May's top batter in the Western League. He batted .405 with 2 home runs, 13 RBIs and 15 runs scored.







Lions Starter Named May's Premier Pitcher: Marvin Buchanan hasn't been around the big leagues long enough to know that youngsters shouldn't be winning Western League Pitcher of the Month. But when you put up numbers like his, you're going to get some notice. In May the Kalamazoo starter earned a 4-1 mark in 5 starts. He threw 49.2 innings, struck out 18 and compiled a solid 1.27 ERA.







Western League Names Rookie of Month: Youngster Gene Terry emerged as the latest Western League Rookie of the Month today. The young man from Detroit deserved the honor, batting .309 with no home runs and 16 RBI. Is the month of May a harbinger of things to come or just a fluke? EASTERN LEAGUE JUNE AWARDS

Hooper of Cleveland EL Batter of the Month: Tom Hooper feasted on Eastern League pitching in June and today he walked off with the Batter of the Month award. The Cleveland shortstop rapped out a .389 batting average while collecting 37 hits, 1 home run, 21 RBIs and 15 runs scored. This season Hooper has delivered 66 hits in 183 at-bats for a .361 average with 2 home runs. He is getting on base at a .431 clip and his totals also include 38 RBIs and 33 runs scored. This year Hooper has played in 47 games.

Barons Hurler Named EL's #1 Starter: Bill Blue's been around the league long enough to appreciate the honor he received today. After going 5-1 in June, the 30-year-old Cleveland hurler has been named Eastern League Pitcher of the Month. He fanned 14 in 53 innings, logged an ERA of 1.53 and allowed opponents to hit .187 against him. This year Blue has compiled a 8-2 mark with a 1.56 ERA in 11 starts.

WESTERN LEAGUE JUNE AWARDS

Wolf Snares WL Top Batter Award in June: On the heels of a very productive June, Rob Wolf received Western League Batter of the Month recognition today. The battle-tested left fielder hit .353 for the Kalamazoo Lions and racked up no home runs, 14 RBIs and 17 runs scored. This season Wolf has 2 home runs and a .321 batting average.

Pitcher of the Month Named in WL: Leo Brock took a much-deserved turn in the spotlight earlier today as he accepted the Western League Pitcher of the Month award for June. The 26-year-old Lions starter is a relative newcomer to the league, but nonetheless racked up an impressive 6-0 won-lost record in 6 starts. This month he fanned 17 batters in 54 innings and compiled a 1.17 ERA. This season Brock has compiled a 9-3 record with a 2.70 ERA.

WL Selects Rookie Star of the Month: Todd Donnelly's eyes seem to light up whenever he sees the baseball. The young Milwaukee second baseman has been hitting everything in sight for the better part of a month. In June he was voted the Rookie of the Month Award. During the month he hit .304 with 1 double, 3 triples and no home runs. Donnelly also scored 4 times and drove in 6 runs. Donnelly is presently hitting at a .291 pace with no home runs, 9 RBIs and has scored 4 times.

Stars Chill Sexton's Hot Streak: The Detroit Stars pitching did its job today, holding hot-hitting Bobby Sexton hitless in 4 at-bats during a 6-5 victory over the Chicago Eagles at Colts Ballpark. This disappointing performance ended his 22-game hitting streak. "I'm a little down right now," Sexton said after the game. "I couldn't get anything going when the team needed me, and I hated to see the streak end, too." Thus far this season Sexton is hitting .379 with 1 home run, 14 RBIs and 10 runs scored. He has 44 hits in 116 at-bats and has played in 29 games.

Munguís Dominates, Whitewashes Wolves: In a knockout performance, Mark Munguís beat the Wolves 17-0 with an impressive 5-hit shutout. The Terriers hurler finished with 11 strikeouts and no walks. He showed pinpoint control and a sharp fastball. Munguís told reporters after the game, "My arm felt good, mechanics were good and my stuff was working... it don't get any better than this." The Wolves manager said, "It was a rough one for my guys. We weren't at

our best... and their guy was." In 8 starts this season, Munguís has recorded 5 wins and absorbed 3 losses. He has pitched 69 innings, allowed 71 hits, struck out 42 and has a 1.83 ERA.
